In October 2020 ICC-ES Acceptance Criteria 519 "Enclosed Booths for In-stallation Inside New and Existing Buildings" (AC 519) were published. AC 519 covers all the relevant building code issues that office pods have faced. All HushOffice acoustic pods are substantially compliant with the require-ments of AC 519, except for 32' clear opening width (HushPhone, HushMeet, HushTwin, HushWork and HushLarge) and the 80" door clear opening height requirement (HushPhone,HushHybrid, HushWet, HushTwin, HushWork and HushLarge) of the IBC. The difference does not compromise the safety or egress possibilities of the occupants using the pod. Please remember that according to AC-519 If an enclosed booth does not comply with the means of egress, accessibility and interior space dimension requirements of IBC Chapters 10, 11 and 12, respectively, the plans must be submitted to, and approved by, the code official at the time of permit application.
